

Week 1- Thursday LIT Plans

Prep work for activities

- Find leadership staff willing to give interviews to the LITs about their experience as a leader.
 - Schedule people for 2x1 interviews and those willing to be shadows
 - Interviews should be done with leadership staff
 - Shadows can be anyone
- Schedule what LIT's gone with which staff
 - Take into consideration Campers' strengths/who they could learn most from
- Interviewing
 - LITs should ask 3-5 questions
 - Answer questions honestly but appropriately, as they are campers
 - Interviewees should make some notes about how the LITs conducted their interviews
 - LITs should be taking notes about the answers given and be able to report back to the group about their experience
- Shadowing
 - LITs will be paired 2X1 with staff to shadow during an activity period
 - Coordinate with Activity Area Directors about how many LITs they can take
 - LITs are encouraged to participate in the activity that they are joining
 - Exciting the activity
 - Encouraging other campers to join in
 - They should also primarily focus on what the staff is doing and how they interact with other campers and staff.
 - LITs are encouraged to take notes and be able to report back to the group about their leadership.
 - If the person they are working with is working through a personal camper issue- LITs should not be part of those conversation.
 - EX: Homesickness, personal issues, etc.

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- LITs can be buddies to other campers if needed.

Activities

Period 1:

Listen to Rule #3 from Wolfpack by Abby Wambach (5-10 min)

- A group can journal, listen, and use friendship bracelets while it is going
- Give space for reflection
 - What resonated with you?

Leadership Interviews/Shadows

- LITs will be interviewing one member of the leadership team and shadowing another counselor
- Why would you be doing this?
- What makes a good interview question?
- LITs should make notes throughout so that they can share out what they learned.

LITs Get assignments

- In their interviewing pairs, generate a list of 3-5+ questions to ask
- Share out what questions they made
 - LITs give others advice about the questions

Period 2:

Leadership Interviews

- LITs do their interviews
- 20-30 Minute

If they are done, they come back to the cabin.

Post Interview

- Journal about experience
- Partners discuss what they want to talk about from the interview
- Come up with a 3-5 minute presentation on what they learned from their interview to present to the cabin
